- May June: G6/7 special field trip instead of camp experience. Could be rock climbing as an example. This is not a for sure plan but a possibility.
- Track & Field: 60% of school still feel uncomfortable. We will do tracks at our school. Probably after Easter in May
- SEL focus: Teachers have completed classroom snapshots to focus on SEL goals for term 3. Mental health continues to be school focus next year until 2024.
