Vaisakhi is a joyful Sikh festival celebrated every April. It marks the birth of the Khalsa and is also a harvest festival in Punjab. People visit Gurdwaras, enjoy music, dancing, and share food in langar. It's a time for community, kindness, and giving thanks.



The International Day of Pink is a day to stand up against bullying, and in particular, bullying because of someone's identity. People wear pink to show support for kindness, inclusion, and respect for everyone. It's a reminder to treat others with love and stand up for what's right.



Bangla Heritage Week celebrates the culture, language, and traditions of the Bangladeshi community. It's a time to enjoy music, dance, food, art, and stories that reflect Bangladeshi heritage. The week helps people learn, share, and feel proud of their roots while building understanding and friendship with others.


