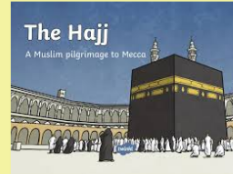

Shavuot: June 1-3
The Hajj: June 4-9
Eid al-Adha: June 7



Shavuot is a two-day Jewish holiday, also known as the Feast of Weeks, that commemorates the giving of the Torah (the first five books of the Hebrew Bible) to Moses on Mount Sinai. It's also a time to celebrate the wheat harvest. Shavuot is a major Jewish holiday, one of the three pilgrimage festivals (along with Passover and Sukkot). It celebrates the completion of the seven week Omer counting period between Passover and Shavuot.



In Islamic terminology, Hajj is a pilgrimage made to the Kaaba, the "House of Allah", in the sacred city of Mecca in Saudi Arabia. It is one of the Five Pillars of Islam, alongside Shahadah (oath that one believes there is no god but Allah), salat (prayer), zakat (almsgiving), and sawm (fasting during Ramadan). An annual pilgrimage to Mecca, all Muslims must take at least once in their lives.

Eid Al
Adha



Eid al-Adha is the Muslim holy day that honors the sacrifice Ibrahim (Abraham) was willing to make in obedience to God's command. Muslims now celebrate this event by sharing a slaughtered animal in three parts: one part for themselves, one for their family, and the third part is given to the needy.
