The day was established in 2005 and is observed annually, coinciding with the anniversary of the Air India Flight 182 tragedy. It serves as a reminder of the impact of terrorism on individuals, families, and communities. The day is recognized by the Canadian government and is observed through various events and ceremonies across the country.




The Islamic New Year, also known as Hijri New Year, marks the beginning of a new year in the Islamic calendar.
