

SUKKOT

Sukkot (also known as the <u>Feast of Booths</u>) is a Jewish holiday that is a combination of a thanksgiving festival and a commemoration of the Israelites' 40 years of wandering in the desert after their Exodus from Egypt. During the week-long holiday, which occurs in the autumn, Jews build and dwell in temporary huts called sukkot (singular: sukkah), a practice that symbolizes the fragile, temporary shelters the Israelites lived in. It also celebrates the fall harvest and is known as the "Season of Our Rejoicing" (Z'man Simchateinu).



World Inclusion Day is an annual event celebrated on October 10th to promote the acceptance, fair treatment, and inclusion of all people, regardless of their abilities, backgrounds, or characteristics. Founded by The Garden Foundation, the day encourages understanding and acceptance of differences, aims to remove societal barriers, and supports creating a more diverse and innovative society



World Mental Health Day is an annual, internationally observed event on October 10th dedicated to raising awareness about mental health issues and mobilizing support for mental well-being worldwide. It serves as an opportunity to learn about mental health, reduce stigma surrounding mental illness, and promote efforts to improve access to mental health services for everyone.



Observed annually on 11 October, International Day of the Girl is a key global moment on which to celebrate girls everywhere, amplifying their voices, actions and leadership.
